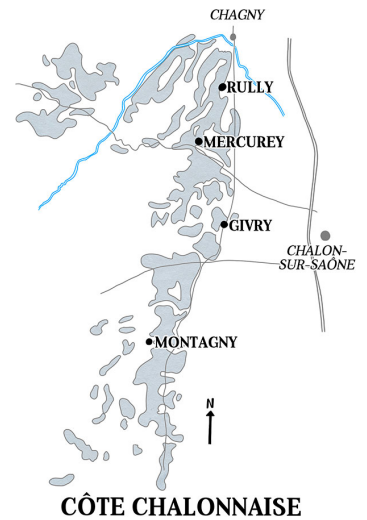


# CHANSON

**Grape Variety :** Chardonnay

**Soil :** Mix of clay and limestone

**Site :** On the hill in the heart of Côte Chalonnaise, the "terroirs" of Rully are perfectly suited for Chardonnay.

**The Vintage 2004 :** Harvest took place at the end of September after a cool and humid Summer with short periods of very hot weather. The "tri", sorting of the grapes was drastic to keep only the very ripe berries.

**Tasting :** Pale gold colour with green nuances. Very refreshing aromas of green almond and fern enhanced by a good minerality. Well-balanced and well-structured. Very refreshing, fruity with a good aromatic combination. Good minerality and long finish.

**Food pairing :** To be enjoyed with charcuterie and poultry as well as some goat cheeses.
