« Prominent wood and menthol nuances are present on the ripe aromas of dark berries, the sauvage and discreet floral whiffs. The exceptionally rich, suave and plush larger-scaled flavors possess a seductive texture that culminates in a relatively refined and moderately powerful finish. This too is going to require at least some patience before it will be completely ready for prime-time drinking”.

What it doesn't possess however is first-class density and while it's by no means dilute, it's prettier than it is deep. "

2007 VINTAGE

“This vintage and the following were vinified by Jean-Pierre Confuron. Grapes come from the same domaine and the same plot. The flowering was early this year but the cold summer slowed down the ripeness. The sun came back in the late autumn. As a consequence, this wine is the culmination of a late harvest because the fruit is very fleshy. Its colour is sustained despite the two thirds of the harvest being in full bunches. 2004 VINTAGE

« It takes charm, as in luck, to find good Charmes Chambertin. But this is one of the good ones, a big, ripe, dense wine that is just setting out on a slow road of aging.
